



VAT Reporting v16.10.3

Release Note

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Overview

This release is an update to 16.10.x following 16.10.1 maintenance release and 16.10.2 patch release of the VAT Reporting application. This delivers new ISAF report for LT and also contains fixes to some critical issues.

Main changes:

- **Poland:** In version 16.10.2 of VAT Reporting, there was a bug in the Polish VAT Book report. Please download this version in order to access the corrected report.
- **Lithuania:** In this release, we now support the new ISAF report in xml format.
- We fixed a bug that was introduced into the system in version 16.9.1: with this bug, invoice processing with more than 500 line items was not handled correctly.
