



VAT Reporting v16.8.2

Release Note

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Overview

This is an update to our recent 16.8.1 maintenance release of VAT Reporting. Please refer to the 16.8.1 release notes for full details of the differences between this and our prior release. In this interim update we have delivered a couple of changes which were not quite ready for the 16.8.1 release date.

VR-816	<p>In this release, we have added a new setting called SAP Integration. Click Settings > General Settings > General > SAP Integration</p> <p>When this is set to Yes, an additional column called SAP Document Type is made available on the following screens: Data Mining, Invoice Lines and Analysis > VAT Code > Analysis Details.</p> <p>The SAP Document Type column is also added to the Excel export on these screens. In addition, the Excel export has been cleaned up to no longer export some unnecessary internal reference columns.</p>	<p>Low - no impact to the core application logic.</p>
VR-781	<p>In the Errors and Warnings panel, there are some circumstances where an item doesn't have the option to expand in the Invoice Flow Details panel when double-clicked.</p> <p>Instead of expanding, there would be a single line displayed prefixed with "..." but with no option to expand into the detail.</p> <p>This has been corrected.</p>	<p>Low - no impact to the core application logic.</p>

Upgrade Procedure

Database Back Up

Before installing the update of VAT Reporting, ensure you have closed any running VAT Reporting windows, and take a full backup of the SQL Database. This can be done in the **SQL Server Management Studio**, from the database right-click menu **Tasks > Back Up...**
